Vial Closure Types



Screw Closure

Top of vial has a threaded "finish" on the top.



Crimp Closure

Used with aluminum seals. Provide larger target area for autosampler.



Snap Closure

Larger opening than standard vials. Used with snap rings and aluminum seals.



Shell Closure

Cylindrical vials used with plug-style closures. Enables microsampling without inserts.
